- You have been abducted,
- You have been deceived by a dishonest agent,
- Someone is demanding you repay money that you have never borrowed,

1. POLICE, PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE AND BORDER GUARD

The Police, the Prosecutor's Office and the Border Guard are services that can bring the perpetrators of this crime to justice. These institutions have departments specialising in the prevention of forced labour. 2. NATIONAL CONSULTING AND INTERVENTION CENTRE FOR THE VICTIMS OF TRAFFICKING

The National Consulting and Intervention Centre for the Victims of Trafficking (KCIK) was established to provide assistance for victims of human trafficking. The services provided by the KCIK are entirely financed from the state budget and commissioned by the minister responsible for internal affairs and administration. The KCIK operations are carried out by the La Strada Foundation Against Trafficking in Persons and Slavery (La Strada Fundacja przeciwko Handlowi Ludźmi i Niewolnictwu) based in Warsaw and the Association for Women and Children "Help" (Stowarzyszenie Pomoc dla Kobiet i Dzieci im. Marii Niepokalanej) from Katowice. The main role of the KCIK includes identifying victims of human trafficking, undertaking intervention where it is necessary, running shelters for victims, and providing counselling services.
