Remuneration is due only for work in meetings conducted in an online, in-person, or hybrid mode. Remuneration is not granted for work performed by circulation.

In justified cases, arising from the specific nature of the programme and the scope of tasks performed by a given Steering Committee, the principles of remuneration for the members/Chair of the Steering Committee may be determined individually for that particular Steering Committee.

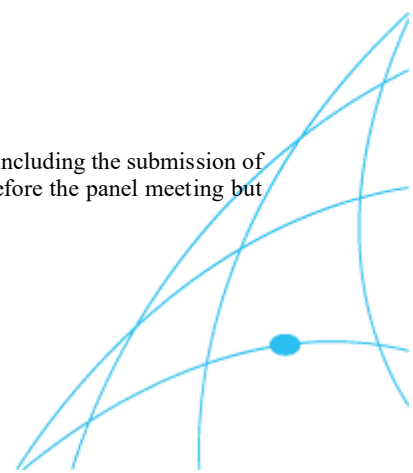
