INFORMATION CLAUSE CONCERNING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to Art. 13 section 1 and 2 art. 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter GDPR), in force since May 25, 2018, I inform that:

4. The recipients of personal data may be:

5. The data will be processed for the duration of the implementation of a specific purpose or until the consent is withdrawn and a request for deletion of personal data is withdrawn. You have the right to request from the Administrators access to your data and receive the first copy thereof, rectification (correction) of your data, deletion and limitation of data processing pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR and Art. 18 GDPR, to object to the processing of data only on the principles described in Art. 21 GDPR, data transfer in accordance with Art. 20 GDPR, withdrawal of consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

7. In order to exercise and obtain information regarding the rights specified above, please contact the Administrators or the Personal Protection Inspector.

8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Office for Personal Data Protection, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw) if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the Personal Data Protection Act, and from May 25, 2018, Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC,
