

Period of Performance: Base Period: 1 January 2022 – 31 December 2022 with four 12-month option

periods.

Bidding Procedure: The intended procurement method will be International Competitive

Bidding (Sealed Bidding) in accordance with Bi-SC Procurement Directive 60-70, Annex B, and Procedures for International Competitive Bidding (2015 Edition). The contract award will be determined based on the contractor that offers the Lowest Price Technically Compliant (LPTC) to

NATO.

Funding: Estimated \$731K (based on full capacity for base and all options)

Travel costs will not be a consideration for contract award.

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Issue Date: Estimated 28 September 2021

Bid Closing Date: Estimated 9 November 2021

Eligibility: Companies which have performed similar tasking to the requirement

described in the solicitation. Contractor personnel performing services under the contract must be citizens of a NATO nation, have appropriate

professional training and experience in a related field (s).
