The Agency's obligation under this project is contingent upon the availability of funds from which payment for contract purposes can be made. No legal liability on the part of the Agency for any payment may arise until funds are made available to the Contracting Officer for this project and until the Contractor receives notice of such availability, to be confirmed in writing by the Contracting Officer.
- **3.** An award will be based on the proposal evaluated as the lowest price, technically compliant in accordance with the selection criteria set forth in the Bidding Instructions.

- **iii.** The Statement of Work. This sets forth the detailed specifications governing the performance requirements of the contract.

- 7. You are requested to complete and return the enclosed acknowledgement of receipt within 5 days of receipt of this RFQ, informing NCI Agency of your intention to bid/not to bid. Your firm is not bound by its initial decision, and if you decide to reverse your stated intention at a later date, you are requested to advise us by a separate letter.
