1. In accordance with the provisions of Article XXXII of the NATO Financial Regulations and Financial Rules and Procedures, we are pleased to inform you that CMRE intends to issue the Invitation for Bids (IFB) stated above in the upcoming months.

2. This procurement action will follow the Formal Procurement procedure specified in Reference A, adopted by the STO CMRE Procurement Procedures.

IFIB Reference: CMRE-22-006

Title of IFIB: Cleaning, Porterage, Custodial and other miscellaneous services.

Requirement: The STO Centre for Maritime Research and Experimentation (CMRE) located

in La Spezia – Italy, has a recurring requirement for daily cleaning services and other miscellaneous support services (e.g. porterage, skilled and unskilled labor for minor construction/repair maintenance work, etc.). The current contract will expire 31 Dec 2022. The intent is to award a new contract for the next five years, starting 1 January 2023. The services are to be performed inside the CMRE's premises, and often during non-conventional duty hours

(especially true for the cleaning services).

Type of Contract: Firm Fixed Price (FFP)

Period of Performance: Performance period is January 1st 2023 - Dec 31st 2023. Four additional

option years are envisioned each of 12 months starting on Jan 1st 2024.

Bidding Procedure: Sealed bid (no negotiations).

Award Method: Lowest Priced Bid.

Funding: Estimated annual amount is 340K Euro.

Estimated cumulative amount over the five years period is approx.

1.7M Euro.

Classification: The solicitation and resulting contract documents are classified NU.

However, unescorted access inside secure areas (Class II) of CMRE is envisioned which requires possession of a personal security clearance (PSC), and in some circumstances may afford access to classified information. Contractor personnel performing the services at CMRE will be required to hold PSCs (at the NS level or higher) by performance

start (i.e. Jan 2023).

IFIB Issue Date: 30 JUN 2022 (TBC)

IFIB Closing Date: 31 AUG 2022 (TBC)

Eligibility: Solicitation is open to all governmental and/or commercial entities that

originate or are chartered/incorporated within NATO-member nations that will have available sufficient number of employees possessing valid NATO personal security clearances at the NS level (or higher) at the time of performance start. All Contractor personnel performing services under the

contract must be citizens of a NATO nation.
