The project will reach out to the vulnerable groups of 34 bordering settlements with a total population of 41981 in two regions through reducing socioeconomic vulnerabilities and facilitating involvement of low-income population in income-generating and production activities, as well as providing access to improved livelihood as a result of rehabilitated community infrastructure. The Project aims at promoting participatory development in target areas facilitating engagement of local population in decision-making at local level and need-based design of local development agenda. The Project pursues the following objectives:

- Objective 1: To foster local participation in development planning and monitoring for bottom-up community development.
- Objective 2: To increase economic activity in the settlements through efficient local production and processing.
- Objective 3: To innovate for improved local production and management.
