Issuance of a Contract will be made on a Firm Fixed Price Basis to the quotation evaluated as the lowest price, technically compliant in accordance with the selection criteria set forth in the Bidding Instructions (Book I) attached to this letter. The NCI Agency has the intention to place a single Purchase Order to cover the entire scope of the project, no partial quotation will be allowed.
- 6. This Request for Quotation (RFQ) consists of the Bidding Instructions (Book I) and the Prospective Contract (Book II). The Prospective Contract contains the Schedule of Supplies and Services (Part I), Contract Special Provisions (Part II), Contract General Provisions (Part III), and the Statement of Work (Part IV). The Statement of Work and the Annexes thereto set forth detailed specifications governing the performance requirements of the contract.
