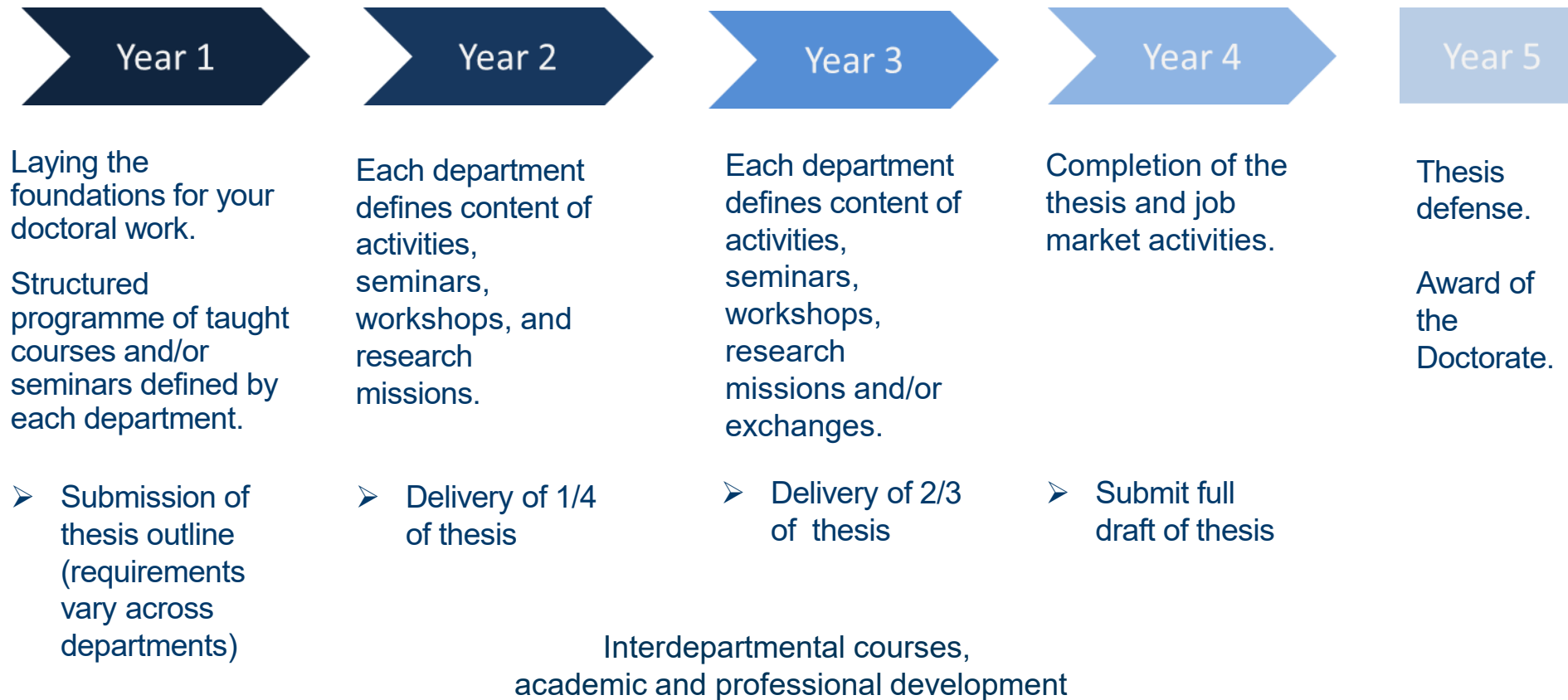

 - Data Protection Practice in Research

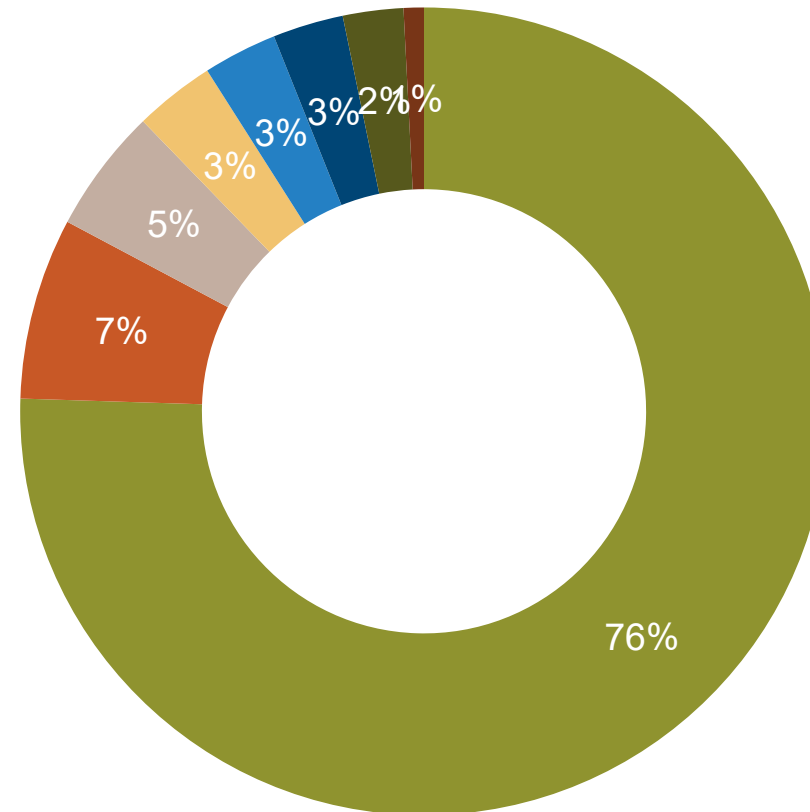

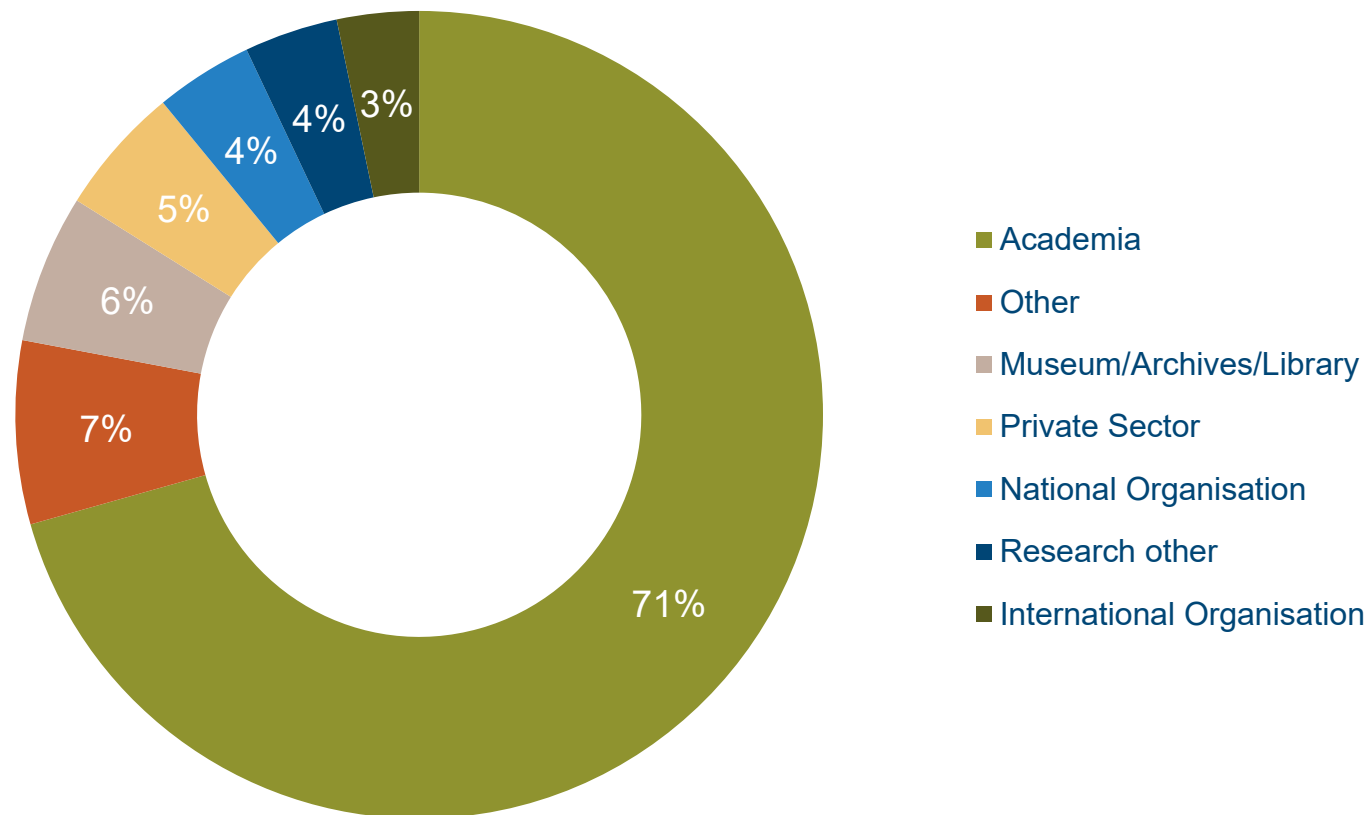

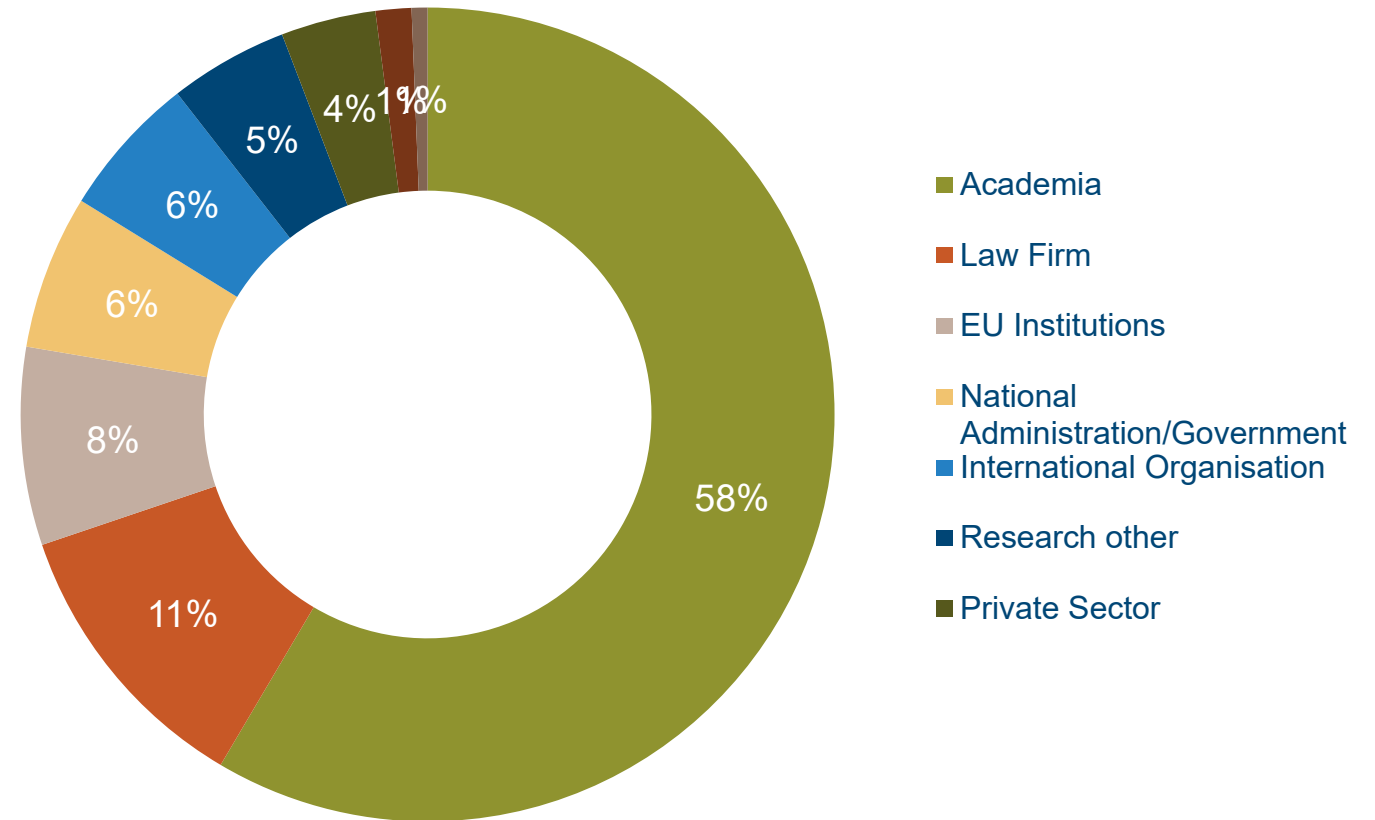
