<b>Budget of the international project</b>	<p><u>NOTE:</u> <b>NCBR may provide funding</b> for project implementation <b>only to Polish entities</b> for industrial research and/or development work!</p> <p>Each Foreign Partner willing to participate in project implementation within the international consortium is required to secure funding for the implementation of their respective portions of the project!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The total funding in the project contributed by all the Foreign Partners forming the international consortium – <b>between 30% and 70%</b> of the overall budget allocated by the international consortium for the project.</li> <li>• The total participation of Polish entities in the eligible costs of the project – between 30% and 70% of the overall budget allocated by the international consortium for the project, additionally: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Minimum amount of funding for the project - PLN 400,000;</li> <li>o Maximum amount of funding for the project - PLN 1.5 million.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>The international consortium agreement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Partnership Agreement</b> for the project implementation between all the partners in international consortium is <b>mandatory</b>;</li> <li>• Should be concluded before submitting the project funding application to NCBR;</li> <li>• Needs to be concluded in writing or electronically (with qualified electronic signatures by all parties to the agreement).</li> </ul>

<b>Other important information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Foreign Partners are obliged to submit a <b>bilingual declaration</b> (Polish and English) that they have <b>secured funding for project implementation</b>.</li> <li>• The declaration indicates directly the source of Partner's funding and lists the tasks planned to be performed by the Partner within the project.</li> <li>• The declaration above should be submitted in writing or electronically, with a qualified electronic signature of the Foreign Partner concerned.</li> </ul>
