**RESOLUTION No. 9/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 25 February 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School of the Eugeniusz Piasecki University of Physical Education in Poznań

run by

the Eugeniusz Piasecki University of Physical Education in Poznań.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025.

Justification:

On 30 July 2025, the Eugeniusz Piasecki University of Physical Education in Poznań submitted for assessment a self-evaluation report concerning the quality of education at the Doctoral School of the Eugeniusz Piasecki University of Physical Education in Poznań for the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025. As part of the evaluation procedure, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted an on-site visit to the School on 14 November 2025, during which it obtained additional information allowing for full verification of the submitted data.

The Evaluation Team stated that, during the period subject to evaluation, the educational process implemented at the Doctoral School of the Eugeniusz Piasecki University of Physical Education in Poznań complied with the applicable law and met the criteria of Level 8 of the Polish Qualifications Framework. The procedures introduced with regard to the course of education were clear, transparent, and implemented in a reliable manner. The educational process was conducted by a qualified academic staff. In the activities of the Doctoral School, positive aspects and practices can be observed that are worth promoting within the academic community, in particular the willingness to develop and strive for the highest scientific standards, the ability to engage in critical self-assessment, and positive relationships among the various stakeholders of the Doctoral School, based on mutual respect and cooperation. The recommendations presented by the Evaluation Team are quality-enhancing in nature and are intended to further improve the functioning of the Doctoral School of the Eugeniusz Piasecki University of Physical Education in Poznań.

Consequently, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the Eugeniusz Piasecki University of Physical Education in Poznań in the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
