

**RULES OF THE 5TH INTERNATIONAL WARMIA CHOPIN COMPETITION
FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE IN LIDZBARK WARMIŃSKI**

April 13, 2025

I. Preliminary information

1. The organizer of the Competition is the State School of Music I st. in Lidzbark Warmiński
2. The scope of the competition is international.
3. Deadline for the Competition: **April 13, 2025.**
4. The purpose of the competition is to present and develop young talents, exchange pedagogical experience, promote Polish piano music in the Northeast Region, as well as promote Lidzbark Warmiński on the national and international arena.
5. **The competition is open to pianists born in 2012 and younger.**
6. The jury will include prominent Polish pianists and pedagogues.
7. All in-studio auditions are open to the public and will take place in the Concert Hall of the State Music School I st Lidzbark Warmiński on a **Fazioli** concert grand piano dedicated to the 16th International Chopin Competition in Warsaw.
8. **In the event of a difficult epidemic situation, the competition may be conducted remotely or may be postponed to another date.**
9. The organizer informs that during the competition and the laureates' concert it may, using its own devices, record video and audio, report in real time on the school channel the course of the auditions, make promotional materials available on the public YouTube channel and the City and Municipality of Lidzbark Warmiński on the municipal Facebook², and will make a photographic recording and use the image of the performers for the purpose of promoting the competition in the public media and other places indicated by the organizer in the administrator's information and permission to disseminate the image.
10. Recordings and photos can also be taken by the media covering the event.

II. Jury

1. The participants' presentations will be judged by a jury composed of:
 - ✓ Prof. Joanna Ławrynowicz - Just - chairman -UMFC Warsaw
 - ✓ Prof. Paweł Zawadzki - AM Wrocław
 - ✓ Prof. Karol Radziwonowicz - UMFC Warsaw, ZPSM No. 1 in Warsaw
2. The deliberations of the Jury are secret, at which the participants will be evaluated, winners will be selected, honorable mentions will be awarded and, in addition, honorable mentions may be awarded.

3. The Jury deliberates in accordance with the Regulations of the Jury's work.
4. Participants will be rated on a scale of 1 - 25 points
5. Distinctions may be awarded to the educators of the participants in the Competition
6. The Jury's decisions on awarding prizes are final and indisputable
7. Students of jurors are not allowed to participate in the competition

III. Program of the Competition

1. Program of the Competition:

- ✓ Any piece by J. S.
- ✓ Any piece by F.

Duration 9 - 12 min.

- ✓ If the duration of both pieces does not exceed 9 minutes, the program should be supplemented with any piece by a Polish composer (F. Chopin's piece is allowed)

2. All songs should be performed from memory

IV. Prizes and diplomas

1. Each participant will receive a commemorative
2. Winners will receive cash prizes
3. The prize pool is PLN 7,000
3. Winner Schools from the Competition Partner will receive additional prizes
4. The announcement of the results will take place during the Laureate Concert
5. List of Winners will be available on the website and at the school's headquarters
6. Winners of the Competition are required to participate in the Winners' Concert, which will be held after the announcement of the results.

V. Applications

1. 2. The application form must be submitted by March 17, 2025.

VI. Exercise rooms

1. The organizer provides:
 - 1) individual exercise room in time proportional to the number of participants
 - 2) acoustic rehearsal at the Concert Hall
2. Rehearsal and competition performance dates will be announced on the School's website under the "Chopin Competition" tab and at the School's headquarters

VII. CONTROLLER'S INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

1.  - 4) Personal data will be processed for purposes related to the conduct of the competition in accordance with the rules of the competition.
 - 5) Personal data will be processed on paper and electronically.
 - 6) Personal data will be stored for the period necessary for the competition, in accordance with the law on archiving and the terms and conditions of YouTube
 - 7) Personal data may be shared with data recipients within the meaning of Article 4(9) of the RODO only within the limits of the law, e.g. with whom the administrator has signed data processing agreements on behalf of the administrator, media and nationwide media in order to promote and report on the competition including: Gazeta Olsztyńska, Gazeta Lidzbarska, TVP Olsztyn as well as the City and Municipality of Lidzbark Warmiński on the city's Facebook and the organizers of external Laureate Concerts
 - 8) Personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making processes by the Administrator, including profiling.

- 9) Anyone who has consented to the processing of personal data has the right to withdraw it at any time. Withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
 - 10) Withdrawal of consent will have consequences of inability to participate in the Competition or its adjudication.
 - 11) Withdrawal of consent may take the following form: I withdraw my consent to the processing of personal data by, given on ... for the purpose of ... Signature of the data subject.
 - 12) Each data subject has the right to request access to, rectification, erasure or restriction of processing of personal data concerning him/her (if not restricted by the fulfillment of a legal provision)
 - 13) Any data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in accordance with Article 77 of the RODO (...any data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, (...) if he or she believes that the processing of personal data concerning him or her violates this Regulation) - Office for Personal Data Protection, 2 Stawki Street, 00-193 Warsaw.
2. At the same time, the Director of the Establishment informs that during organized ceremonies, exhibitions, concerts and other publicly open events (in front of spectators, guests, listeners), the provisions of Article 81 paragraph 2 of the Act of February 4, 1994 apply. on Copyright and Related Rights ("2. Permission is not required to disseminate the image of: 1) a well-known person, if the image was made in connection with his/her performance of public functions, in particular political, social, professional functions; 2) a person constituting only a detail of a whole such as a gathering, landscape, public event)
- Publicly open events at the Outpost may be recorded and distributed on the organizer's website and social media. Those who participate in the event accept the above conditions.

- Taking, publishing and sharing photos, recordings made individually by participants of the event, open ceremonies is done solely at their own risk and awareness of the consequences of unauthorized dissemination of the image of others without their consent and permission.
