**RESOLUTION No. 33/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 27 May 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the KUE Doctoral School

run by

the Krakow University of Economics.

This evaluation applies to the period from 21 October 2019 to 22 September 2025.

Justification:

On 11 December 2025, the Krakow University of Economics submitted for evaluation a self-assessment report regarding the quality of education at the KUE Doctoral School during the period under review. As part of the evaluation process, the Evaluation Team, appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee, reviewed the documentation and conducted an on-site visit to the School on 5 March 2026, during which it obtained additional information that enabled full verification of the data presented.

The Evaluation Team concluded that, during the evaluation period, the educational process implemented at the KUE Doctoral School run by the University of Economics in Krakow met all criteria identified in the evaluation process. These criteria were assessed positively by the Evaluation Team. Detailed information is presented in the individual sections of the evaluation report. The comments raised and the identified shortcomings did not disrupt the overall functioning of the KUE Doctoral School. The Evaluation Team presented recommendations to the KUE Doctoral School that, if implemented, will improve the quality of the educational process. The educational process was characterized by coherent organization, a high level of academic content, and the commitment of the academic staff, which contributed to improving the quality of education and the development of doctoral students.

In light of the above, the Evaluation Team unanimously decided to give a positive assessment of the quality of education at the KUE Doctoral School run by the University of Economics in Krakow during the period under evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.

An entity dissatisfied with the evaluation may, pursuant to Art. 262(4) of the Act, raise objections to this evaluation within 30 days from the date of delivery of this resolution.
