OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 30 July 2025**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Article 259 (1) and Article 262 (2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the "Act", having reviewed the result of the evaluation referred to in Article 262 (1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluate the quality of education

at the Doctoral School of the Medical University of Wrocław

run by

Medical University of Wrocław.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 18 December 2024.

Justification:

The education process at the evaluated Doctoral School of the Medical University of Wrocław, in the disciplines of medical sciences, health sciences and pharmaceutical sciences, meets the criteria set out in the applicable law. The recruitment rules for the Doctoral School have been defined clearly and unambiguously in accordance with their content. The Doctoral School's curriculum and individual research plans correspond to the characteristics of the learning outcomes for qualifications at level 8 of the Polish Qualification Framework. The verification of learning outcomes is characterised by accessibility, reliability and transparency, and features a high level of use of modern digitalisation methods. The quality of scientific supervision and support in conducting research activities has been assessed very positively. The mid-term evaluation procedure at the Doctoral School is characterised by impartiality, objectivity and transparency of the process. The degree of internationalisation of the School received a very high assessment. The cooperation between the Doctoral School and the doctoral student council is marked by open and constructive dialogue and takes place in a positive atmosphere. Particularly positive was the assessment of the high effectiveness of doctoral training at the evaluated Doctoral School.
