The EU policy on responsible sourcing of minerals includes Regulation (EU) 2017/821 which sets out due diligence obligations for Union importers of tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold (the so-called “3TGs”). The overarching objective of this policy is to break the nexus between armed conflict and the illegal exploitation of minerals so as to contribute to peace, development and stability in conflict-affected and high-risk areas.

As part of the EU's ongoing efforts to increase transparency in mineral supply chains and to encourage due diligence in downstream sectors using these metals and minerals, the Commission has created a platform to be used by economic operators in order to publicly share information on their efforts to ensure responsible supply chains of metals and minerals. In addition to downstream companies

using 3TGs, the platform is open to all companies throughout the mineral supply and value chain, including with respect to other metals and minerals. The use of the platform is voluntary and without prejudice to potential obligations a specific operator may have under the EU Regulation. ## Modules of the Responsible Minerals Information System



## Front Office

Web portal accessible<sup>1</sup> by economic operators (upstream or downstream companies) that wish to share their due diligence policies and practices. Once logged in, as first step, economic operators' representatives need to register their organisation. After the registration request is validated by the national competent authorities, they can submit the due diligence information.

## Back Office


A second module is accessible by national competent authorities to validate the economic operator registration requests and by the Trade Service Desk to support economic operators and to facilitate the publication of the due diligence information on the Europa website.

## Public portal

A third module available through the Europa website: <https://ec.europa.eu/responsible-mineral-sourcing/portal> where public can search and download due diligence information.

**1)** The security access to the system is based on the Commission authorisation system EU LOGIN. An EU LOGIN account with a second factor authentication must be created. The account can be easily created on the EU LOGIN website: <https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/cas/>. The second factor authentication can be configured, by downloading an installing the EU Mobile App (procedure available [here](#)).





Economic operators should also indicate if they are covered by supply chain industry scheme(s) and if they have any legal obligations to carry out due diligence on their mineral supply chains.


## Step 3: due diligence information
