

GDPR Information Clause and Scope of Consents

28th Kłodzko Piano Competition

Information Regarding Acceptance

This document outlines the rules for processing personal data and the content of the consents required to participate in the Competition. According to the regulations, acceptance of the terms below occurs by checking the appropriate boxes in the electronic application form. This document does not require a handwritten signature.

I. Scope and Content of Consents

Based on Art. 6(1)(a) of the GDPR, the Participant (or their legal guardian), by submitting the application, expresses voluntary consent for:

- **Organization and Artistic Evaluation:** Processing personal data (including name, surname, date of birth, and submitted video recordings/links in case of online competition) to verify the application, assign the participant to an age category, and for the Jury to evaluate the performance.
 - **Publication of Results:** Publicly sharing the name, surname, and result achieved on the Organizers' websites, social media (e.g., Facebook, Instagram), in the press, on the radio, and in promotional materials.
 - **Use of Image:** The free-of-charge, repeated dissemination of the participant's image recorded during stationary auditions, live broadcasts, or contained in submitted competition recordings for the Organizers' promotional and archival purposes.

II. Information Clause (Information Obligation)

1. Data Controller The controller of personal data is **Fundacja Partita**, ul. Zaułek Rogoziński 13/22, 51-116 Wrocław.

2. Purposes and Legal Bases for Processing

- **Consent (Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR):** Implementation of the competition process (including age verification based on a document scan), publication of results, and promotion of the competition.
- **Legal Obligation (Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR):** Financial and tax settlements for winners of cash prizes and scholarships.
- **Legitimate Interest (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR):** Documentation of the competition's progress and the establishment or defense of legal claims.

3. Data Recipients Data may be transferred to:

- Technological entities supporting the competition (e.g., Google, YouTube for video services).
- Payment processors (e.g., paypal.com for entry fee verification).

- Co-organizers and event Partners (e.g., the host school PSM I st. im. F. Chopina in Klodzko or prize founders).
- The general public (results and image in the media).

4. Data Retention Period

- **Participants:** For the time necessary to conduct the competition and its promotion.
- **Prize Winners:** For a period of 5 years in accordance with tax law.
- **Archiving:** In accordance with the Act on National Archival Resources.

5. Rights of Data Subjects You have the right to access your data, rectify it, erase it, limit its processing, transfer data, and object to processing. You also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.

6. Complaint to a Supervisory Authority You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw).

7. Voluntary Provision of Data Providing data is voluntary; however, it is a necessary condition for participating in the Competition.

8. Profiling Data will not be subject to profiling.
