REGULATION

OF THE MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR AND ADMINISTRATION¹⁾

of 13 March 2020

on temporary suspension or limitation of border traffic at specific border crossing points

Pursuant to Article 16(3)(2) of the Act of 12 October 1990 on the Protection of the State Border (Journal of Laws of 2019, item 1776) it is hereby ordered as follows:

- §1. As of 15 March 2020 0:00 hours, border traffic at border crossing points with the Russian Federation, the Republic of Belarus and Ukraine, listed in Attachment no. 1 to the regulation, shall be suspended until further notice.
- **§2.** As of 15 March 2020 0:00 hours, border traffic at border crossing points with the Russian Federation, the Republic of Belarus and Ukraine, listed in Attachment no. 2 together with the type of border traffic permitted at these crossing points, shall be limited until further notice.
- §3. 1. As of 15 March 2020 0:00 hours, border traffic at border crossing points with the Federal Republic of Germany, the Czech Republic, the Republic of Lithuania, the Slovak Republic, and at air and sea border crossing points shall be limited until further notice.
- 2. The limitation, referred to in paragraph 1, consists in the limitation of incoming passenger traffic at border crossing points of the Republic of Poland, to the following categories of persons crossing the state border at air and sea border crossing points and persons crossing state border by passenger cars at road border crossing points:
- 1) citizens of the Republic of Poland;
- 2) foreigners who are spouses or children of citizens of the Republic of Poland or who remain under permanent care of citizens of the Republic of Poland;
- 3) holders of the Pole's Card;
- 4) heads of diplomatic missions and members of diplomatic and consular staff of missions, i.e. persons with a diplomatic rank, and their family members;
- 5) foreigners who have permanent or temporary residence permit in the territory of the Republic of Poland;
- 6) foreigners who have the right to work in the territory of the Republic of Poland, i.e. foreigners who have the right to perform work based on the same rules as Polish citizens, who have work permit, seasonal work permit, declaration on entrusting work to a foreigner in the territory of the Republic of Poland;
- 7) in particularly justified cases, which have not been listed above, the commanding officer of a Border Guard outpost, upon authorisation of the Commander-in-Chief of the Polish Border Guard, can

allow a foreigner to enter the territory of the Republic of Poland according to the procedure set out in the Act of 12 December 2013 on Foreigners (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 35);

- 8) foreigners operating vehicles that transport goods;
- **§4.** The regulation shall enter into force on the date of its promulgation.
