**RESOLUTION No. 1/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 14 January 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School in the Humanities

run by

the Jagiellonian University in Kraków.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025.

Justification:

On 8 August 2025, Jagiellonian University in Kraków submitted for assessment a self-evaluation report concerning the functioning of the Doctoral School in the Humanities for the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025. The Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted a site visit at the School on 15 October 2025, during which it verified the documentation and obtained new data.

The Evaluation Team stated that the educational process at the Doctoral School in the Humanities run by the Jagiellonian University in Kraków in the period subject to evaluation fulfilled all evaluation criteria at a very high level, providing substantial support for the preparation of doctoral dissertations. Teaching activities were conducted by a highly qualified academic staff from both Poland and abroad, and the doctoral candidates’ achievements in terms of publications and the acquisition of research grants deserve special recognition. The recruitment process and mid-term evaluations were conducted in a transparent and reliable manner, the doctoral students’ council cooperated closely with the authorities of the doctoral school, who implemented numerous valuable initiatives contributing to the School’s continuous development.

Consequently, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the Doctoral School in the Humanities run by the Jagiellonian University in Kraków in the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
