**RESOLUTION No. 8/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 25 February 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School of the Christian Theological Academy in Warsaw

run by

the Christian Theological Academy in Warsaw.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025.

Justification:

On 4 August 2025, Christian Theological Academy in Warsaw submitted for assessment a self-evaluation report concerning the quality of education at the Doctoral School for the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025. As part of the evaluation procedure, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted an on-site visit to the Doctoral School on 17 November 2025, during which it obtained additional information allowing for a full verification of the submitted data.

The Evaluation Team concluded that during the period under evaluation, the educational process implemented at the Doctoral School of the Christian Theological Academy in Warsaw was compliant with the requirements of Polish Qualifications Framework level 8 and implemented very well. The educational process was led by qualified staff, and the University provided doctoral students with extensive access to research and academic infrastructure, including library resources, and created conditions for conducting scientific research at both the national and international levels. The effectiveness of doctoral education also earned a positive assessment. The Evaluation Team found that the recruitment and mid-term evaluation processes were conducted reliably, and its recommendations were promptly implemented. In the opinion of the Evaluation Team, the Doctoral School authorities and academic staff cooperated well with the Doctoral Student Self-Government and the community, with particular emphasis on ecumenical and religious relations given the nature of the University.

Therefore, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the Doctoral School of the Christian Theological Academy in Warsaw during the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
