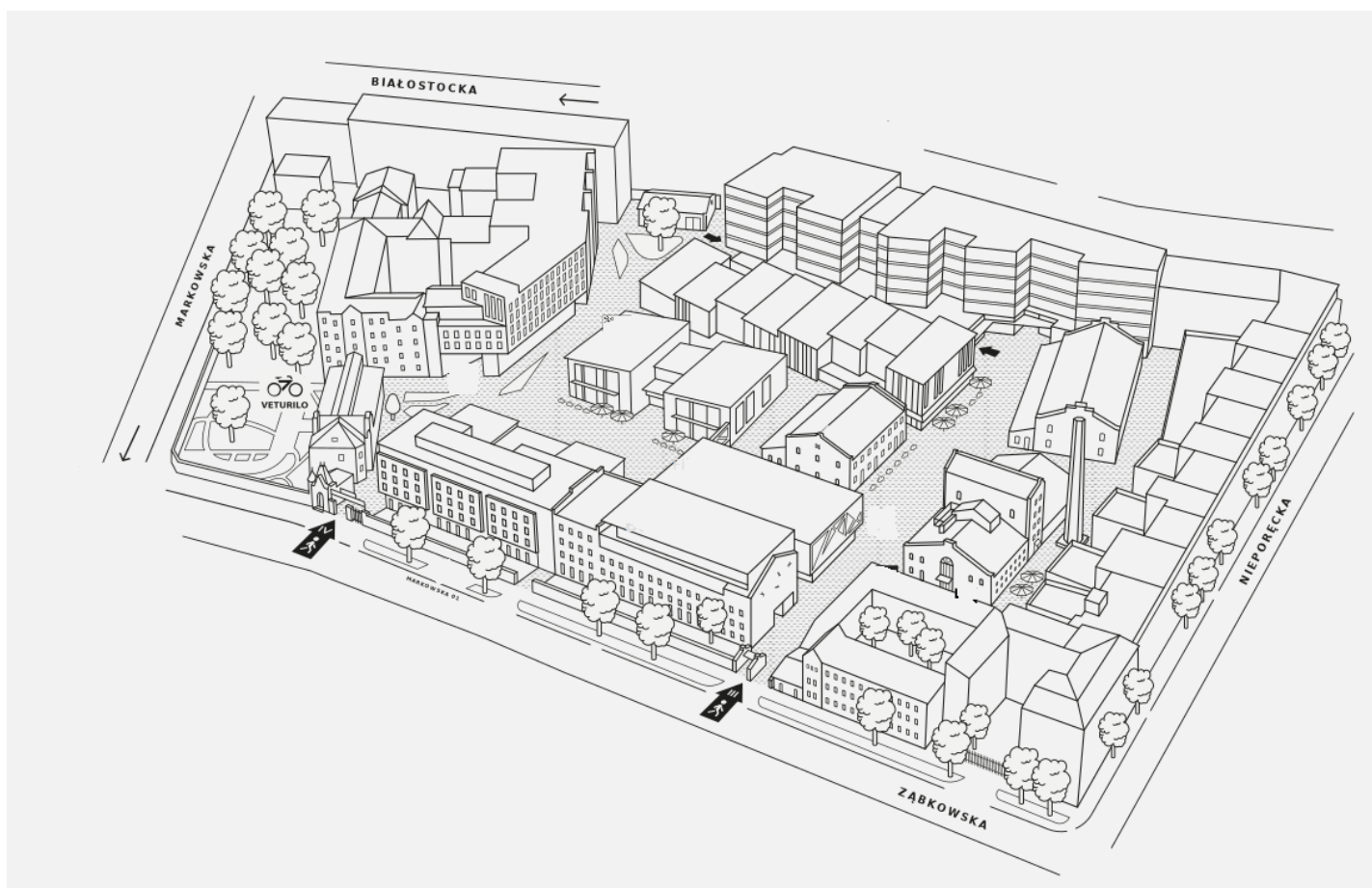

Access Information

Centrum Praskie Koneser

Pedestrians: For those arriving on foot, access is via two access points on Żąbkowska Street. Only those on the approved attendees list are permitted to enter the Butelkownia and Filtracja buildings.

Access by Car for Head of Delegation: Heads of Delegation (and those accompanying them) arriving by car enter through the underground parking facility. They will enter the Butelkownia building through the elevator.



Registration and Badges

Embassies will be provided with welcome packages and badges prior to the Ministerial, with a request to distribute them to delegations. The Ministry of Climate and Environment of Poland will provide a briefing for the Embassies the week before the P-TECC program. More information will follow.

Catering

TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION

Hotels

A variety of hotels are within close distance to the P-TECC meeting facilities. Organizers will not provide hotel accommodation for participants.

Poland's COVID-19 Entry Restrictions

Schengen Travelers

- Mandatory 10 days quarantine **unless** the traveler presents a negative COVID-19 test taken no later than 48 hours before crossing the Polish border. Acceptable tests: PCR or antigen.
- **Exemptions from Quarantine:**
 - Person is recovered or vaccinated against COVID-19. Note: vaccine must be certified in the EU.
- Rules apply to all modes of transport – public and individual as well as crossing border on foot.

Non-Schengen Travelers

- Mandatory 10 days quarantine – **negative COVID-19 test taken in the country of departure does not release from quarantine.**
- **Exemptions From Quarantine:**
 - a. person recovered or vaccinated against COVID-19. Note: vaccine must be certified in the EU.

- b. staying in Poland from arrival no longer than 24 hours and having a confirmed airline ticket departure from Poland within 24 hours,
- c. legally residing in EU/EEA but transiting Poland,
- d. travelling for professional, official or employment reasons:
 - Members of diplomatic missions, consular posts and representatives of international organizations and their family members, and by others persons crossing the border on the basis of a diplomatic passport,

Restrictions may change as the situation develops; this note will be updated accordingly.

COVID SAFETY

Precautions

The U.S. and Polish teams organizing the P-TECC program are closely following COVID developments and are taking every precaution to help ensure the health and safety of all participants.

We are limiting the total number of attendees at the P-TECC Ministerial for safety reasons – the delegation should consist of the head of delegation (HOD) + three accompanying persons.

We kindly ask that all P-TECC attendees:

1. Regardless of vaccination status, provide proof of a negative COVID test conducted on or after September 19th. Either Antigen or PCR test is acceptable.
2. Wear a mask while indoors at the P-TECC Business Forum and Ministerial, unless you are giving remarks, eating, or drinking.
3. Apply all necessary measures of personal safety including keeping a safe distance.

Note: Chopin Airport in Warsaw offers on-site testing for arrivals. We can provide a list of COVID-19 testing locations in Warsaw upon request.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Conference Language

The conference will be conducted in English. Simultaneous interpretation will not be available.
