**RESOLUTION No. 11/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 25 February 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School

run by

the Jan Matejko Academy of Fine Arts in Kraków.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025.

Justification:

On 4 August 2025, Jan Matejko Academy of Fine Arts in Kraków submitted for assessment a self-evaluation report concerning the quality of education at the Doctoral School run by the Jan Matejko Academy of Fine Arts in Kraków for the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025. As part of the evaluation procedure, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted an on-site visit to the Doctoral School on 27 November 2025, during which it obtained additional information allowing for full verification of the submitted data.

The Evaluation Team found that the educational process implemented at the Doctoral School run by the Jan Matejko Academy of Fine Arts in Krakow during the period under evaluation, as well as its recruitment process, was highly positive. To ensure the clarity and transparency of the evaluation, the team included detailed comments and assessments regarding individual criteria in the report. This document contains a detailed analysis of every aspect of the Doctoral School's operation, including comments on the recruitment process, educational organization, and cooperation with the academic community and the doctoral student self-government. This report not only serves as a basis for the conclusions reached, but also as a useful tool for supporting the further improvement of the Doctoral School's activities.

Consequently, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the Doctoral School run by the Jan Matejko Academy of Fine Arts in Kraków in the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
