

**OECD NCP Information note on the notification of alleged breach of  
the *OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises*  
Warsaw, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021**

The OECD National Contact Point (OECD NCP) informs that on June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 the Polish OECD NCP received a notification of an alleged breach of the *OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises* (hereinafter: OECD Guidelines) by a Polish multinational enterprise. The notification was submitted by an individual.

After analysis of the notification and separate meetings with parties to the proceedings, on the 18<sup>th</sup> of January 2021 the OECD NCP accepted the case for further consideration, underlining that the acceptance of the case does not mean that the NCP confirms that the OECD Guidelines were breached.

The Initial Assessment of the case prepared by the OECD NCP has been agreed between the parties to the proceedings. For the good of the case, the OECD NCP decided not to publish the content of the Initial Assessment and to leave it in the specific instance documentation.

At a later stage of the proceedings, the OECD NCP will propose to the parties mediation or its good offices, to find a solution that will be satisfactory for both parties.

Proceedings before the OECD NCP are confidential, which means that the details of the talks and the considered directions of action will not be disclosed to the public. The proceedings before the OECD NCP will end with the formulation of the Final Statement, describing the various stages of the proceedings and information on the conclusion of an agreement (or its lack) between the parties.

The Final Statement will be published in Polish and in English on the OECD NCP's website.
