**RESOLUTION No. 35/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 27 May 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School of the Medical University of Lublin

run by

the Medical University of Lublin.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 10 September 2025.

Justification:

The Medical University of Lublin, on 1 December 2025, submitted for evaluation a self-assessment report concerning the quality of education at the Doctoral School of the Medical University of Lublin for the period from 1 October 2019 to 10 September 2025. As part of the evaluation procedure, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted an on-site visit to the Doctoral School on 17 February 2026. During the visit, additional information was obtained, allowing for a comprehensive verification of the data previously provided.

The Evaluation Team concluded that, in the period under evaluation, the educational process carried out at the Doctoral School of the Medical University of Lublin complied with the requirements of Level 8 of the Polish Qualifications Framework and was delivered to a high standard. The verification of learning outcomes was characterized by accessibility, reliability, and transparency. The educational process was conducted by highly qualified academic staff, and the University ensured doctoral candidates broad access to research and scientific infrastructure, as well as favourable conditions for conducting research at both national and international levels. The quality of academic supervision and support for research activities was assessed very positively. The mid-term evaluation procedure at the Doctoral School was characterized by impartiality, soundness, and transparency. The level of internationalization of the School received a very high evaluation. Cooperation between the Doctoral School and the doctoral students' self-government was marked by openness and constructive dialogue, and took place in a positive atmosphere. The effectiveness of doctoral education was also assessed positively.

In view of the above, the Evaluation Team positively assessed the quality of education at the Doctoral School of the Medical University of Lublin for the period under review.

Having reviewed the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
