### **DESCRIPTION (scope, expectations, remarks):**

**I. Carrying out works for the Department of the Theory of Combustion Processes and Explosions of the Faculty of Fire Safety Engineering including in particular:**

- Lectures, classes, including laboratory classes in the field of knowledge concerning combustion of building products (materials) and explosions resulting from industrial breakdowns, in Polish. The applicant is expected to devise didactic materials, including textbooks or instructions for classes. A further responsibility are publications in the field of technical sciences in the discipline of environment engineering.

**II. Requirements to be met by candidate:**

- Education: min. PhD in forest sciences, field of forest sciences, discipline of arboriculture,
- professional experience: min. 5 years on the position of assistant professor in a university school,
- work experience on similar position: min. 5-year didactic experience and documented publications from the period of the last 5 years related to flammability of wood and wood-based products and the impact of those processes on the environment,
- professional skills: familiarity with research methods as regards flammability of building products, especially methods used to evaluate susceptibility to ignition, flame spreading, smoke release intensity and toxicity. In addition knowledge concerning the execution of tests for a thermogravimetric analysis and related to heat generation kinetics with the use of a cone calorimeter.

**III. Required documents:**

- representation concerning the possibility of taking up full-time research and didactic work in the Main School of Fire Service pursuant to regulations of the Act on higher education (Polish Journal of Laws/Dz. U. from 2016 item 1842).
- application for employment,

- personal questionnaire of the applicant,
- curriculum vitae presenting the progress of teaching and didactic work to date and a list of publications,
- copy of diploma confirming the award of the PhD title or the degree in forest sciences, field of forest sciences, discipline of arboriculture and other documents certifying the applicant's qualifications and research and didactic achievements,
- statement that the applicant meets criteria specified in Article 109 par. 1 item 2-5 of the Act on higher education dated 27 July 2005 (Polish Journal of Laws/Dz. U. from 2016 item 1842),
- declaration of agreement to processing of personal data for purposes connected with implementation of the competition.
