In the framework of compulsory courses for all incoming BSc Students on the Hungarian program and for all international Students on both BSc and MSc programs both in Budapest and Szombathely

- Mentoring
 - once a week
 - Mentor Teacher and Senior Student
 - 20 Students / group
- Soft skill trainings
 - Partially lead by Psychologist Trainers with a contract
