

**RESOLUTION No. 2/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 14 January 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School of Social Sciences

run by

the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025.

Justification:

On 4 August 2025, Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin submitted for assessment a self-evaluation report concerning the functioning of the Doctoral School of Social Sciences for the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025. As part of the evaluation procedure, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted a site visit at the School on 16-17 October 2025, during which it obtained additional information allowing for full verification of the data submitted by the Entity.

The Evaluation Team stated that, during the period subject to evaluation, the educational process at the Doctoral School of Social Sciences run by the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin was conducted appropriately. The Evaluation Team concluded that the process implemented by the School enables doctoral candidates to achieve the intended learning outcomes, consistent with the requirements of Level 8 of the Polish Qualifications Framework. The high level of the academic staff competence, combined with a well-conceived, coherent and appropriately designed curriculum, contributes to the very high quality and effectiveness of the entire teaching and learning process.

Consequently, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the Doctoral School of Social Sciences run by the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin in the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
