Please note that the travel insurance valid for the entire period of intended stay is required also applying for a work visa.  If you are already working in Poland and insured by Polish social insurance (ZUS), you can submit a certificate from them (ZUS RMUA Raport miesięczny dla osoby u bezpieczonej instead.  Information of the Minister of Foreign Affairs about the insurers and the insurance is that they offer, which meet the necessary conditions referred to in Article 25 (1) (2) (a) and Article 25 (1b) of the Act of 12 December 2013 on Foreigners is available on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
