- **Coordination and Support Action (CSA)** under the Digital Europe Programme
- **No development or deployment of new AI solutions**
- **Focus on coordination, evaluation, replication and scaling** of existing GenAI pilots
- **Target: European public administrations**

Institutional GenAI needs (as case studies):

- User and staff support through **sovereign RAG-based chatbots** (enrolment, mobility, access to procedures)
- **Exploitation of unstructured documents** (data extraction and structuring to support automation)
- **Cross-cutting use cases:** multilingual access, speech-to-text and transcription
