The Challenge

European administrations rely on 'GenAI fastfood' - expensive, opaque AI from non-EU providers (OpenAI, Copilot, Gemini) that are often misaligned with EU values.

Our Solution: Europe's Community Kitchen

A trusted infrastructure where Member States co-create and share GenAI solutions. We're building the kitchen, recipes, and ingredients that let European administrations prepare wholesome GenAI solutions tailored to their needs, compliant with EU regulations, rooted in European values.

Impact measurement
