**RESOLUTION No. 39/2025
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 17 December 2025**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School at the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences

run by

the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025.

Justification:

Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences submitted a self-assessment report on the functioning of the Doctoral School at the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences for evaluation within the deadline, together with the required supplementary materials. As part of the evaluation process, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Commission reviewed the documentation and then conducted a site visit on 7-8 October 2025, during which it obtained additional information allowing for full verification of the submitted data.

The Evaluation Team found that, during the period subject to evaluation, the education process carried out at the Doctoral School at the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences was conducted at a very high level and fully met the requirements set for Level 8 of the Polish Qualifications Framework. The organization of education, the commitment of the academic staff, and the quality of support offered to doctoral candidates demonstrated the maturity and high effectiveness of the unit's operations. The School had clearly defined and appropriate learning outcomes, and the methods used to verify them were coherent and reliable. The curriculum, supplemented with effective tools for monitoring progress – including the mid-term evaluation involving external committees – supported the development of doctoral candidates' research competencies. The scientific achievements and the quality of work of the academic staff were highly valued, as was the high level of internationalization of the education process, including systematic support for international doctoral candidates and the active involvement of external experts in teaching and promotional activities. The areas identified as requiring clarification were of an improving nature only.

In view of the above, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the Doctoral School at the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences in the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Commission decided as stated in the introduction.
