**RESOLUTION No. 39/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 10 June 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the SGH Doctoral School

run by

the SGH Warsaw School of Economics.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 10 September 2025.

Justification:

On 3 December 2025, SGH Warsaw School of Economics submitted for assessment a self-evaluation report concerning the quality of education at the SGH Doctoral School during the period under evaluation. As part of the evaluation procedure, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted an on-site visit to the School on 3 March 2026, during which it obtained additional information allowing for full verification of the submitted data.

At the SGH Doctoral School, all criteria identified during the evaluation process were met, and the Evaluation Team issued a positive assessment. The doctoral education program was characterized by high quality, consistent organization, and an appropriate level of academic rigor. Noteworthy was the functioning system for ensuring academic standards, which encompassed the integrity of scientific research, the verification of doctoral students' work, cooperation with the doctoral student council, and organizational, substantive, and psychological support. The activities of the SGH Doctoral School were coherently embedded within the university's strategy and structure, with a clearly defined role and profile. The Evaluation Team presented detailed information in the individual sections of the evaluation report. The comments and shortcomings identified do not disrupt the overall functioning of the SGH Doctoral School. The evaluation report includes recommendations that, if implemented, will improve the quality of the educational process.

Consequently, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the SGH Doctoral School in the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
