Kementerian Luar Negeri Republik Indonesia menyampaikan salam hormatnya kepada seluruh Perwakilan Negara Asing (PNA) dan Organisasi Internasional (OI) di Indonesia, dan melalui nota edaran ini bermaksud untuk memberikan *update* perkembangan kebijakan Pemerintah Republik Indonesia dalam penanganan penyebaran Covid-19 melalui terbitnya: **Surat Edaran Satuan Tugas Nasional Penanganan COVID-19 No. 2 Tahun 2022** tentang Protokol Kesehatan Perjalanan Luar Negeri Pada Masa Pandemi COVID-19 yang ditindaklanjuti pula dengan penerbitan **Nota Edaran Kementerian, No. SE/4/PK/01/2022/64**, maka disampaikan *update* hal-hal pokok yang perlu diketahui oleh seluruh Perwakilan Negara Asing (PNA) dan Organisasi internasional (OI) dari kebijakan Pemerintah Republik Indonesia sebagai berikut:

1. Seluruh pelaku perjalanan internasional Warga Negara Asing (WNA) yang akan memasuki wilayah Republik Indonesia perlu menyesuaikan kembali dokumen perjalanan agar sesuai dengan ketentuan kategori WNA yang diizinkan memasuki Indonesia, yang meliputi: sertifikat vaksinasi, ketentuan tes PCR, dan masa kekarantinaan.
2. Pemerintah Indonesia telah **menganulir** penutupan sementara masuknya Warga Negara Asing (WNA) secara langsung maupun transit dalam kurun waktu 14 (empat belas) hari terakhir dari tempat-tempat/negara sebagaimana tercantum pada **Nota Edaran Kementerian, No. SE/4/PK/01/2022/64**.
3. Ketentuan waktu isolasi (karantina) berlaku bagi seluruh pelaku perjalanan luar negeri bagi seluruh WNA pelaku perjalanan internasional adalah sebagai mana berikut:
 - a. Masa karantina **7 x 24 jam**, bagi seluruh WNA pelaku perjalanan internasional dengan biaya seluruhnya ditanggung mandiri oleh WNA.
 - b. Dalam hal kepala perwakilan asing diplomatik dan keluarga dapat melakukan isolasi mandiri di kediaman diplomatik selama **7 x 24 jam**, diharapkan agar melaporkan hasil tes RT-PCR-nya kepada Satuan Tugas Covid-19 melalui Kementerian Luar Negeri. Pengambilan tes RT-PCR dilakukan sebanyak 2 kali, yaitu **1 x 24 jam (di Airport saat ketibaan)** di wilayah Republik Indonesia dan pada hari keenam karantina (**setelah 6 x 24 jam**).
4. Permohonan terkait kekarantinaan harus diajukan dengan pemberitahuan sekurang-kurangnya **7 x 24 jam sebelum kedatangan**, melalui Nota Verbal dengan dukungan data lengkap. Selanjutnya akan dilakukan pertimbangan khusus mengenai permohonan dimaksud (**Catatan: Permohonan kurang dari jumlah hari tersebut, akan ditolak**).
5. Kebijakan diatas bersifat **sementara dan akan disesuaikan kembali** sesuai perkembangan kesehatan.

Kementerian Luar Negeri Republik Indonesia menggunakan kesempatan ini untuk sekali lagi menyampaikan penghargaan yang setinggi-tingginya kepada Perwakilan Negara Asing dan Organisasi Internasional di Indonesia.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia presents its compliments to all Foreign Missions (PNA) and International Organizations (OI) in Indonesia, and through this circular note intends to provide updates on the development of policies of the Government of the Republic of Indonesia in handling the spread of Covid-19 through the recent announced regulations namely: **Circular Letter of the Covid-19 Task Force No. 2 of 2022** concerning Health Protocol for International Travel During the Covid-19 Pandemic Period and which subsequently was followed up by the Ministry's Circular Note, **No. SE/4/PK/01/2022/64**, therefore further informs about the following updates on the policies to all Foreign Missions and International Organizations, as follows:

1. All international travelers of foreign nationals who will enter the territory of the Republic of Indonesia shall make readjustments with regards to their travel documents, to ensure compliance with the provisions regarding categories of foreigner nationals allowed to enter Indonesia, which includes: vaccination certificates, PCR test provisions, and quarantine duration.
2. The Government of Indonesia **annulled** the temporary closure of the entry of Foreign Nationals (WNA) directly or transit within the last 14 (fourteen) days from places/countries as stated in the Ministry's **Circular Note No. SE/4/PK/01/2022/64**.
3. The provision regarding the duration of isolation (quarantine) applies for all international travelers with the following categories:
 - a. Quarantine duration of **7 x 24 hours**, for all international travelers of foreign nationals, with all costs borne independently by the foreign nationals.
 - b. In the event that the head of the foreign missions and/or international organizations and his family are permitted to undertake self-quarantine at the diplomatic residence for **7 x 24 hours**, they are expected to report RT-PCR test results to the Covid-19 Task Force through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia. The RT-PCR test must be carried out 2 times: **1 x 24 hours** after arrival in the Indonesian territory (**at the airport**) and on the sixth day of self-quarantine (after **6 x 24 hours**).
4. The request for a recommendation to enter Indonesian territory and discretion regarding quarantine shall be submitted with **at least 7 x 24 hours notification prior to arrival**, by sending a Verbale Note with completed supporting documents. The Ministry shall afterwards make specific considerations with regard to the submitted request. **(Note: Applications submitted less than 7 x 24 hours, will not be processed).**
5. The above policies are temporary and will be readjusted according to global health developments.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs avails itself of this opportunity to renew to all Foreign Missions and International Organizations in Indonesia, the assurances of its highest consideration.
