

Notification of Intent - Establishment of Aircraft Parking Apron at Karup Air Base, Denmark - National Competitive Bidding Plus

Background

The Danish Defense Estates Agency (DDEA) on behalf of the Ministry of Defense Denmark intends to issue an invitation to submit bids for a contract under the rules and procedures for National Competitive Bidding Plus (NCB+), as defined by the NATO Security Investment Programme (NSIP). The project will cover establishment of a new Parking and Maintenance Platform for four Air-to-Air Refuelling (AAR) aircrafts, widening of connecting taxiways, Fuel Installations for three Hydrants and restoring pavement of the main runway at Karup Air Base, located in the middle of Jutland in Denmark. With this Notification of Intent, (NOI), the DDEA aims to ensure that eligible firms from any NATO member nation are informed of and invited to participate in the upcoming competition.

In accordance with the NATO rules and regulations, firms from the following NATO member nations may participate in the competition:

Albania, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Croatia, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Montenegro, Netherlands, North Macedonia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Türkiye, United Kingdom, United States.

Time Schedule

The competition documents will be disclosed on the 18th of December 2023 on ted.europa.eu. Firms that wish to participate on the prequalification must apply before the deadline on the 17th of January 2024. The approved firms will on the 30rd of January receive an invitation to tender.

Execution of the contract is scheduled for the first quarter of 2024 and ends 2025.

Work description

The competition will include one contract containing the following work

- Establishment of a new Parking and Maintenance Platform for four Air-to-Air Refuelling (AAR) aircrafts, widening of connecting taxiways, Fuel Installations for three Hydrants.
- The Parking and maintenance platform will have a total area of approximately 23.000 m². The connecting taxiways will have an estimated area of 223.000 m².
- The work will mainly contain asphalt and concrete works.
- An option on restoring the pavement of the main runway.

The contract holds an estimated value of Euro 20.000.000

Terms and conditions

Terms and conditions regarding participation in the competition will be a part of the tender material. All documents, including terms and conditions, and time schedule can be found on ted.europa.eu after disclosure on the 18th of December 2023.

The contract will be executed as one overall main contract and will rely on the conditions in the Danish General Conditions for Building and Construction Works and Supplies (AB18).

All documentation will be written in Danish. Applications for prequalification as well as tender must also be written in Danish.

Security

The documentation will be unclassified.

It is a criterion in the contract that the appointed firm can provide personnel that is or can be authorised to handle information up to and including NATO RESTRICTED. For key personnel on site, a valid NATO Security Clearance up to and including NATO CONFIDENTIAL is required.

Further information regarding security requirements will be presented in the competition documentation.
