The Three Seas Initiative aims to stimulate the economic development of Central and Eastern European countries, as well as to strengthen the development of its regions. The initiative brings together 12 countries of the region: Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Lithuania, Latvia, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia and Hungary. The creation of a stable and coherent partnership

of countries in the area between the Baltic Sea, the Adriatic Sea and the Black Sea has a positive impact on the increase of the competitiveness of this area within the EU and globally.

Lublin and the Lubelskie region take a unique place in European history. Here, under the Union of Lublin formed in 1569, that the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth was created, which for over 200 years was the most democratic multi-ethnic state in Europe. Based on this message of our ancestors, we wish to build the future and economic strength of the entire region of Central and Eastern Europe.

Working together as part of the Three Seas Initiative, we strive to expand infrastructure, energy and digital connections, and thus create new international networks of business interconnections.
