PROJECT DESCRIPTION

ENTRE investigates the mechanisms of change in EU foreign and security policy through a theory-driven analysis of how policy ideas are translated into institutional outcomes within the EU's multilevel governance system and the broader European security architecture. It develops a novel analytical framework that integrates public policy analysis, political science, and International Relations, with a particular emphasis on agency and its interaction with structural constraints. Advancing the Multiple Streams Approach, the project conceptualizes policy change as the result of strategic action by multiple policy entrepreneurs operating across national, EU, and global levels, who link policy ideas to political and contextual conditions at critical moments of the policy process. Methodologically, the project employs process tracing and comparative case studies, complemented by elite surveys and in-depth interviews, to analyse both successful and unsuccessful instances of EU foreign policy change in the security and defence domain.

JOB DESCRIPTION

The successful candidate will be appointed as a Postdoctoral Researcher (Assistant Professor) in the Institute of Political Studies of the Polish Academy of Science (Chair for European Studies) and will contribute substantively to the empirical, methodological, and analytical components of the ENTRE project. The postdoctoral researcher will work under the supervision of the Principal Investigator, Prof. Monika Sus and in and other project collaborators and is expected to take an active role in data collection, analysis, publication, and dissemination of results. Her/Hir primary responsibility will be to design and conduct the elite study on foreign and security preferences in close cooperation with the PI. To this end the researcher will participate in project meetings, workshops, and dedicated international conferences and be actively involved in the academic life of the Institute of Political Studies.
