**RESOLUTION No. 43/2025
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 17 December 2025**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School of the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn

run by

the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025.

Justification:

On 4 August 2025, the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn submitted for assessment a self-evaluation report concerning the functioning of the Doctoral School of the UMW in Olsztyn for the period from 1 October 2019 to 11 May 2025. As part of the evaluation procedure, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted a site visit at the School on 20–22 October 2025, during which it obtained additional information allowing for full verification of the submitted data.

The Evaluation Team stated that, during the period subject to evaluation, the education process implemented at the Doctoral School of the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn was conducted at a very high level and fully met the requirements laid down for Level 8 of the Polish Qualifications Framework. The organisation of education, the commitment of the staff, and the support offered to doctoral students demonstrated the high efficiency of the unit's operations. The School possessed clearly defined and adequate learning outcomes, and the methods used to verify them were predominantly consistent and reliable. The curriculum and the mid-term evaluation fostered the development of doctoral students' research competencies, and the scientific achievements and the quality of the staff's work were rated highly. The Doctoral School of the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn also undertook activities regarding internationalisation. The effectiveness of doctoral training was also assessed positively. The suggestions and recommendations contained in the evaluation report serve as guidelines for the further improvement of the School's activities.

Consequently, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the Doctoral School of the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn in the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.
