TO THE IMMIGRATION OFFICES OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

The Embassy of the Republic Poland hereby confirms that the Republic of Poland is currently in the state of lockdown, with closed external borders, and not accepting inbound travels. As a result, Polish citizens are not able to leave Indonesia before the expiry date of their visa or other types of stay permits.

Therefore, the Embassy kindly requests the Immigration Office of the Republic of Indonesia to extend the visa or right of stay (kitas) or grant the Emergency Stay Permit (Izin Tinggal Keadaan Terpaksa) to the Polish citizen presenting this letter.

The Embassy furthermore asks the Immigration Office to lift all the applicable penalty charges for overstay. The overstay that might have happened until this time, was caused due to the current situation (*Vis Major*), without the fault of the Polish citizen.
