**RESOLUTION No. 24/2026
OF THE SCIENCE EVALUATION COMMITTEE
of 15 April 2026**

on the evaluation of the quality of education at a doctoral school

Pursuant to Art. 259(1) and Art. 262(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal Laws of 2024, item 1571, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the “Act”, having reviewed the results of the evaluation referred to in Art. 262(1) of the Act, which was carried out by the Evaluation Team, the Science Evaluation Committee

positively evaluates the quality of education

at the Doctoral School at the Wrocław University of Health and Sport Sciences

run by

the Wrocław University of Health and Sport Sciences.

This evaluation applies to the period from 1 October 2019 to 10 September 2025.

Justification:

On 1 December 2025, Wrocław University of Health and Sport Sciences submitted for assessment a self-evaluation report concerning the quality of education at the Doctoral School at the Wrocław University of Health and Sport Sciences during the period under evaluation. As part of the evaluation procedure, the Evaluation Team appointed by the Chair of the Science Evaluation Committee reviewed the documentation and subsequently conducted an on-site visit to the Doctoral School on 28 January 2026, during which it obtained additional information allowing for full verification of the submitted data.

The Evaluation Team stated that, during the period subject to evaluation, the educational process implemented at the Doctoral School at the Wrocław University of Health and Sport Sciences met all evaluation criteria. The analysed and assessed education program met the requirements for level 8 of the Polish Qualifications Framework and supported the preparation of a doctoral dissertation. The education process was delivered by qualified staff, and the University provided doctoral students with extensive access to research and scientific infrastructure, including library resources, and created conditions for conducting scientific research. The effectiveness of doctoral education also earned a positive assessment. The Evaluation Team found that the recruitment and mid-term evaluation processes were conducted properly. The Evaluation Team assessed the doctoral education process at the evaluated doctoral school as adequate.

Consequently, the Evaluation Team decided to positively assess the quality of education at the Doctoral School at the Wrocław University of Health and Sport Sciences in the period subject to evaluation.

Having examined the documentation, the Science Evaluation Committee decided as stated in the introduction.

An entity dissatisfied with the evaluation may, pursuant to Art. 262(4) of the Act, raise objections to this evaluation within 30 days from the date of delivery of this resolution.
